Dear ASC,

For our Halloween Function on Oct. 26th we spent \$11 on tablecloths, \$23 on crackers and bowls, \$50 on candy and cookies, \$50 on drinks and ice, \$50 for Rent on the Function held at Survivors Club. We took in only \$40 on Donations and the 50/50 split was \$73. A total of \$123 for the function. We lost on the Function but gained in Registrations since the cutoff date for early Registration.

Camp Recovery- Sam's trip was \$1120. Other expenses- fuel, wood, campsite, airs and crafts, misc. totaled \$218. Receipts attached. We had 61 Registrations, 5 people paid day rate of \$20. We sold every T-shirt and hoodie except 2 smalls. We sold \$764 in raffle tickets. 50/50 split was \$382. Auction raised \$1934. We had \$2790 in cash and \$1025 in cards for a total of \$4197.

Thank you to all who donated, served, gave and was willing to participate in both Functions.

Today I am turning in \$3677 in cash. Credit cards were 1025.78. (\$4702.78 total)

The LA Region now has a helpline @ 1-585-DONT-USE. This helpline is currently disseminating meeting information and forwarding to area helplines. I am working on a configuration where each area will have the option of call routing using the region helpline by accessing their own admin panel. This would give us the option of phasing out our existing number and using the region number if we choose to do so in the future. If you call our area right now through the region helpline it calls me. This is temporary as I am in the middle of coding this.

I'd like to encourage everyone to speak up and get involved. There is definitely a place on the PR subcommittee for anyone who wants to help. If any of you or anyone in your group is interested please contact me. This is a WE thing and TOGETHER WE CAN is not just a catchphrase.
