## March 2020 Public Relations Report

In the past month I have been extensively working on the helpline. It is now configured in such a way that we will be using the Region Yap install without

having to have a twilio number and still be able to do our own volunteer routing. This will cut our costs on the helpline to zero when we drop Freedomvoice in a couple of months. If anyone is interested in being a helpline volunteer there will be a workshop after April ASC.

Daniel, Greg, & I attended a Rural Opiod Summit last month at Homer High School in Homer, LA. It was quite informative and we made a lot of good contacts and passed out a lot of information packs. I will be following up on this in the coming weeks.

In Springhill we have been given permission by the city to install bench back signs on benches owned by the city. There are two or more benches per block downtown as well as benches by city hall and city court. We have bought ten 12" x 18" signs and now just have to decide where to put them.

I have samples of two metal signs today. The larger signs we are using in Springhill for the bench backs  $\cos t \sim 12.00$  ea. I also have a 8" x 12" sign that would work better in businesses such as motel offices or apartment complexes, etc. that  $\cos t \sim 10.00$  ea. I'd like to hear everyone's ideas on whether either (or both) of these signs would be viable in Shreveport/Bossier as well as Ruston and Farmerville. If we can get permission to put them in high traffic areas or areas with a high traffic of addicts it would be much more effective in carrying the message as well as more cost effective than commercial signs such as bus stop bench backs.

Wish me luck at RSC next month on presenting the Billboard Proposal. I really would love to see NA billboards scattered around the state.
